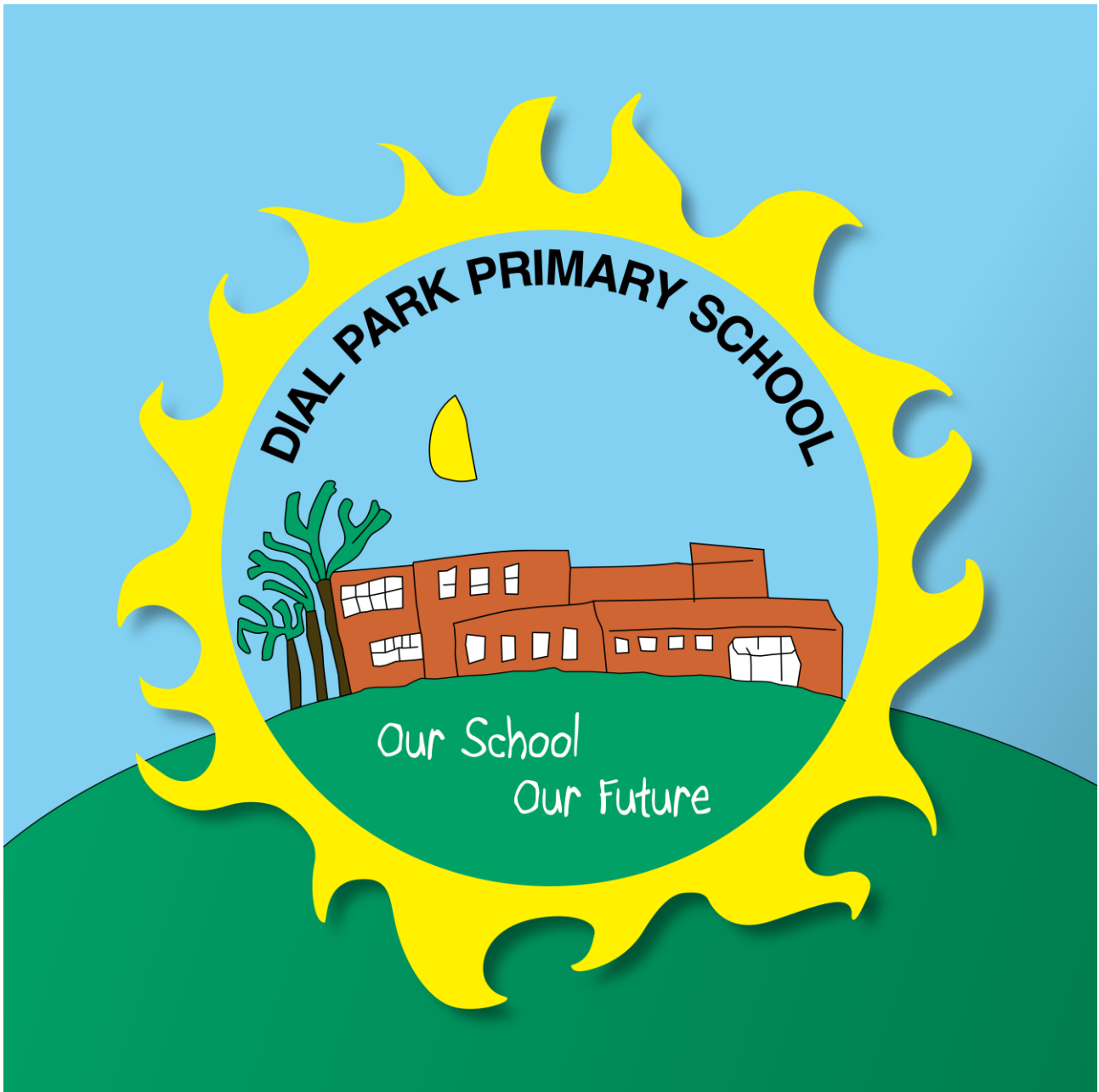


# Dial Park Primary School Website Privacy Policy



We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our website visitors; this policy sets out how we will treat your personal information.

## **(1) What information do we collect?**

We may collect, store, and use the following kinds of personal data:

- Information about your visits to and use of this website;
- Information about any transactions carried out between you and us on or in relation to this website;
- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of registering with us, leaving guestbook comments, subscribing to our website services, and/or email notifications.

## **(2) Information about website visits**

We may collect information about your computer and your visits to this website, such as your IP address, geographical location, browser type, referral source, length of visit, and number of page views. We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a text file sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The text file is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page. This enables the web server to identify and track the web browser.
