Notes:

- BRP has been used more this year than last and progress has been very good.
- SERI scores are disappointing but this is largely due to the TA running it having personal home problems so consistency has been poor.
- Children have made more progress on Reading Recovery this year than last year. Six more children are due to exit the programme towards the end of September /October.
- Leicester Inference continues to make amazing progress for groups of seven. Individual Leicester Inference was used for a child with poor retention/ concentration and again proved to be very successful.

- The individualised year 6 reading intervention started as a Reading Recovery type lesson, moving on to a Leicester Inference approach with some extra phonics/morpheme work added in. This child had EAL and has made great progress.
