

## May 2020 Intervention Data Analysis

- BRP reading ages and comprehension ages are similar to previous years.
- Reading Recovery ages for all children (including pupil premium children) are similar to previous years.
- Phonics Counts phonics ages are similar to previous years. Phonics Counts reading ages have dropped. Phonics Counts pupil premium children's reading ages and phonics ages are similar to previous years.
- Inference reading ages and comprehension ages have dropped for all groups of children.

### Notes:

- In Phonics Counts the reading age has dropped for the fourth year. Why? These children have left the intervention sometimes having moved up ten book band levels when assessed which is excellent progress. This may be due to the fact that halfway through the intervention I have switched to a "Reading Recovery" approach as the phonics books became too easy? Regardless of the final scores I feel that the children left the intervention with much improved reading, as did their class teachers.
- The inference scores are based on five children, two of whom have very spiky profiles and are having SEN interventions.

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
