

Leicester Inference Training



Who is it for?

- For children in key stages 1,2 & 3 who have reasonable decoding skills but need to boost their comprehension skills.

What does it involve?

- It's a group session for about 5 - 8 pupils. A short extract is read together. Unknown vocabulary is discussed and children generate their own questions about the text. They are then asked to summarise the text visually, adding their own unique section to fit into the text.

What does the training involve?

- A two day course containing three main elements:
 - a. Professional development materials to help schools explore ways of improving comprehension & enjoyment in reading.
 - b. Best practice comprehension teaching and learning strategies for class teachers.
 - c. A group intervention of a variety of lessons for pupils who need extra support and which connect to ongoing teaching so pupils generalise their skills.
