Knowledge block 1

Revisit book creator and read each others books from KS1 learning. Edit any mistakes to each others books and make some improvements. Remember all of the tools you used and practise using them again.

Knowledge block 2

Find the continent page that you are learning about now in Geography in your Book Creator Book. Use current learning and the internet to find out facts about that continent/city. Ensure the facts are correct by using legitimate websites - check with an adult if you are unsure.

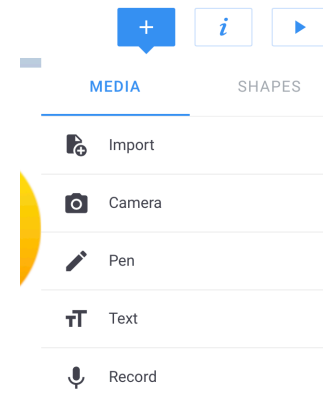

Knowledge block 3

On the new pages of your book add in more detail. Specifically - land use patterns over time, mountains, hills, coasts and rivers; settlements, economic activity over time and the distribution of resources over time.

Knowledge block 5

Press the play button and watch with a friend. Ask them to check and edit mistakes.
Then share the books as a whole class!

Knowledge block 4

Go back over your pages and now begin to make comparisons from LKS2 learning and UKS learning to make extra pages which compare and contrast the similarities and differences of your geographical study. Use the voice over tool to explain how facts and findings are the same or different to other places you have studied.
